

GOODBYE TO THE OLD TOILET BLOCK



One of Chellaston's less-loved landmarks, the public conveniences on High Street which have been closed for over ten years, was demolished in March as the first phase of the redevelopment of the site to create a new community garden. The contractor, Cawarden, cleared the site and levelled the ground in less than a week ready for landscaping to start soon. The Garden Partnership are expecting that the garden will be completed and planted up in time for residents to enjoy it during the summer.

The cost of the garden has been increasing but we do not wish to cut corners in any way because we hope this will be a lasting legacy for Chellaston.
