Chellaston Action Group is now once again able to work on the beds and planters that we have been looking after on High Street and elsewhere. We have started with some remedial work which involved the emptying of some of the planters to install new membranes which will help to stop them becoming waterlogged. These have

now been replanted. Other beds have also been revived and are looking much better for it. The bench on the corner of St. Peter's Road has been repainted in preparation for new planters which have been kindly donated by Rainbridge Timber Ltd of Alfreton which the WI are going to plant up. We also had a few daffodil bulbs left over from those donated by Planter's Nurseries last year and they were put in pots over the Winter but we have now planted them in a patch at the corner of Maple Drive and Derby Road. Further planting is being carried out as soon as the risk of frost subsides and we are looking forward to a colourful Summer in Chellaston!
