

## **COMMUNITY GARDEN MOVES FORWARD**

We are very pleased that the project to create a community garden on the site of the disused toilet block on High Street has moved forward with the granting of funding from recent new developments which is designed to enhance the area in which they are located. All three of our ward councillors have agreed that the garden is a worthy project to receive specific funding for public open spaces and public art and we are grateful for their support. Without these funding streams, we could not go ahead with the project and, even with this money, we will still have a shortfall which we hope to cover mainly from business donations. The CRA itself has already contributed on behalf of residents, made possible from funds that the "100 Club" generates.



The design now incorporates flower beds, including a circular bed in the centre which will have an information panel. The entrances will be marked by metal arches which are being designed by a Derbyshire metalworker who will also provide graphic icons of Chellaston

for the back wall. There will be ample seating designed in wood and we do hope that residents and those passing through will want to spend a few minutes there to relax, at least when the weather is good! We certainly expect that the garden will become a feature in the centre of Chellaston for many years to come.
