The Chellaston Community Plan will provide guidance for the City's planners about future development, regeneration and conservation of the area. It's also about the use and development of land and as such it will help to design future local plans produced by the City Council. It will have legal weight and will be a statutory document to be used in making decisions on planning applications.
