

**Police and Crime Commissioner Visits Chellaston**

Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) Hardyal Dhindsa talked to local residents in the Community Centre last month as part of his #D383 tour of Derbyshire to listen to the concerns that matter to our community.

Mr Dhindsa outlined the responsibilities of the PCC which are to provide strategic oversight for the police, the production of a police and crime plan and the commissioning of services for victims of crime. Residents brought up local issues of anti-social behaviour and vandalism in the local school during the school holidays, parking, the lack of an obvious police presence and the attendance of Safer Neighbourhood Teams at local community meetings.
