The “Chellaston in Bloom” Project



This year the CRA has been discussing with community groups and businesses the feasibility of Chellaston taking part in the “It’s Your Neighbourhood” section of the East Midlands in Bloom Project. The idea for this has sprung up from the CRA Environmental Task Action Group, which was launched by us back in 2017. These volunteers have been working on Saturday mornings to enhance various areas around the village which had become neglected. The projects have included tidying up the “Spirit” bank, around the old toilet area, maintaining the Penfold and the areas around the shops on High Street.

Earlier this year we had a visit from the lead organiser from Littleover in Bloom who gave us very encouraging advice but stressed the importance of involving and consulting with the whole community to develop a sense of ownership and pride.

From this we have drafted a route around the Village with 9 areas that could be improved to meet the criteria of the project including those we have already been working on. The idea is that different groups could take responsibility for individual areas.

Additionally, we have consulted City Council staff who have been out to have a look at the key areas and advised on whether the areas we have chosen are safe to work on. The council has also kindly agreed to support us by including some preparation work as part of their normal visits over the coming months, such as weed killing, trimming trees etc.

This is an exciting development for Chellaston, but importantly, we do not have to renovate the entire Chellaston area in order to enter the competition. However, its success will depend on consulting with and involving residents, community groups, Councillors etc. The CRA will use Facebook, newsletters etc. to raise awareness and get your views and inputs. We do want to hear from you!
